Landscape Installation:

All aspects of new installation projects.

- Assist in landscape bed layout & site analysis.
- Use proper bed preparation techniques.
- Assist in nursery plant material selection & layout of plants according to design.
- Be involved in planting, staking, fertilizing, mulching & watering.



Weekly Site Maintenance:

- Work with experienced on-site maintenance crew.
- Visit commercial & residential maintenance sites on a weekly basis.
- Learn fundamental maintenance practices for mowing, edging, & weed control.
- Learn how to use different pieces of equipment & various pesticides & herbicides.



Design Sales:

- Work with Registered Landscape Architect.
- Learn to do site take offs & analysis, to put together a Landscape Plan.
- Attend meetings with potential & existing clients. Hopefully seeing a project from start to finish.
- Learn different design techniques; hand drawings, AutoCAD & Photoshop as a few examples.
- Learn the importance of proper design & installation to make the maintenance process much simpler.



Seasonal Color:

Month of May

- Learn to layout & install annual flower beds.
- Learn the importance of soil amending, fertilizing & watering.
- Learn basic concepts in custom container designs.



Pruning:

Summer work

- Work with Horticulturist.
- Learn proper pruning techniques for different plant species.
- Work with both deciduous & evergreen materials (Plant Identification).
- Maintain perennials, use proper dead heading & plant clean up techniques.
